


# TRIAL LUMBAR WRAP


General information about Elements Body can be found on our website.

The Trial Lumbar Wrap is an evaluation tool to establish if the user will benefit from an Elements Body compression garment. The Trial Lumbar Wrap can be used for up to two weeks for evaluation purposes. It is advised that this product is administered to no more than 10 patients for evaluation, and it can be used for a maximum of two weeks or less per user. When issuing the lumbar wrap, it is advised that the treating clinician instructs on the correct fitting to both the user and care giver.

## Product description

Textile lumbar wrap with hook and loop adjustment in centre front and with additional straps to provide support and alignment of the hips.

## Intended use and Indications

The lumbar wrap is intended to be used for assessment purposes only, prior to the provision of Elements Body garment. The lumbar wrap is intended for short term use for a maximum of two weeks and is a useful assessment tool within the clinic setting.

## Contraindications

The lumbar wrap is intended to be used for assessment purposes only, prior the provision of an Elements Body garment.

## Sizes

3 adult sizes (S-M-L)

3 paediatric sizes (XXS-XS-S)

## Limitations:

The Lumbar Wrap can be used by up to 10 patients for evaluation, for a maximum of two weeks usage per patient.

The prescriber is responsible for providing a clean and damage free product to the next user. See product for wash and care information. The product chart can be utilised to document usage. The product may only be used as an Elements Body evaluation tool.

## Cautions

- Should not be used damp
- Not flame retardant
- Check garment and skin daily before usage
- Product should be washed and examined between change of users


## Material Specifications

Polyester, Polyamide and Spandex. POM stays

## Washing Instructions



Machine wash at 60°C between test patients



Close the hook and loop adjustment straps before washing.

## Inspection

- Product is intact and free from damages
- Seams are intact
- Washing label is still readable
- Hook and Loop still has good fastening ability
- Feel the material to ensure that the stays in the back are intact
- If the test patient is suspected of having an infection dispose of the product immediately

## Disposal

Disposal in accordance with local legislation.
